No proposal will be accepted unless it is made on a Proposal form furnished by the City of Corning, or facsimile thereof. Each Proposal must be accompanied by cash, certified or cashier's check, or bidder's bond payable to the City of Corning for an amount equal to ten percent (10%) of the amount bid, such guaranty to be forfeited should the bidder to whom the Contract is awarded fail to execute the contract Documents.

Pursuant to Section 1770, and following, of the California Labor Code, the successful bidder shall pay not less than the prevailing rate of per diem wages as determined by the Director of the California Department of Industrial Relations. Copies of such prevailing rate of per diem wages are on file at the city hall. The successful bidder shall post a copy of such determination at the job site.

No proposal will be accepted from a Contractor who is not currently licensed in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 9, Division III of the Business and Professions Code. Subcontractors shall also be licensed as required by said code. The work to be done will require a Class "A" General Engineering Contractor License.

Contract Documents, including Plans and Specifications, may be obtained at the office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 794 Third Street, Corning, CA 96021, (530-824-7029), for a non-refundable cost of \$20.00.

The Contract, if awarded, will be awarded to the lowest responsible bidder as determined by the City. The City of Corning reserves the right to waive irregularities, accept or reject any and all bids, and make that award which is in the best interest of the City.

Bidders are hereby notified that in accordance with the provisions of Government Code Section 4590, securities may be substituted for any monies which the City may withhold pursuant to the terms of the Contract to insure performance.
